Als Vorlage zu diesem Stück diente mir der Film „All About Eve“ des Regisseurs Joseph L. Mankiewicz, einer bitterbösen sich um Theaterintrigen drehenden Satire, in der Bette Davis als Diva zur Höchstform aufläuft. Ein Kurzauftritt der jungen Marylin Monroe, der nahe gelegt wird, sie solle mangels Talent ihr Glück doch beim Fernsehen versuchen, liefert dem 1950 gedrehten und 1951 mit mehreren Oscars bedachten Film nachträglich eine zusätzliche ironische Pointe.

Da meine langjährige Partnerin ebenfalls Eva heißt und gelernte Flötistin ist, heißt dieses 2008 für sie komponierte Stück „Something about Eve“. Es beginnt mit einer einfachen Kadenz in e-Moll, die sich langsam erweitert und in harmonisch veränderter Form immer wieder auftaucht, abgelöst von sehr rhythmischen Stellen in „Double-Time“, also doppelt so schnell. Wobei es nur ein Tempo gibt, das zwischen-durch von freigestalteten Rubatostellen abgelöst wird. Sowohl Klavier als auch Flöte sollen sehr „sanglich“ klingen.

This piece was inspired by the film “All About Eve” by director Joseph L. Mankiewicz, a very black satire of theater intrigue in which Bette Davis delivers a tour de force performance as a diva. A short appearance of the young Marylin Monroe portraying a young actress who, with her lack in talent, is turned down with the suggestion that she should try her luck in TV gives the 1950 film, which had won several Oscars in 1951, an additional, if retrospective, ironic touch.

As my longtime partner is also called Eva, a professional flutist, this piece from 2008 is called “Something about Eve”. It starts out with a simple E minor cadence which is gradually widened and constantly reappears in harmonically transformed form, alternating with highly rhythmical sections in double time. There is only one tempo which is sometimes relieved by free rubato sections. Both piano and flute should sound very “songlike”.
